National Webinar

"The Life and Philosophy of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji"



A National Webinar to commemorate the 400th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Tegh Bahadir Ji with the theme of "The **Life and Philosophy of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji**" was jointly organized by the Department of English, Hindi and Punjabi (Triveni) on May 20, 2021. The webinar began at 11:00 am via Google meet with Dr.Ila Rathor (Head, Department of English) welcoming Principal, Dr.Meena Chopra and the resource persons. Dr.Chopra extended a warm welcome to the esteemed speakers, and highlighted the importance of organizing webinars on such themes.
