

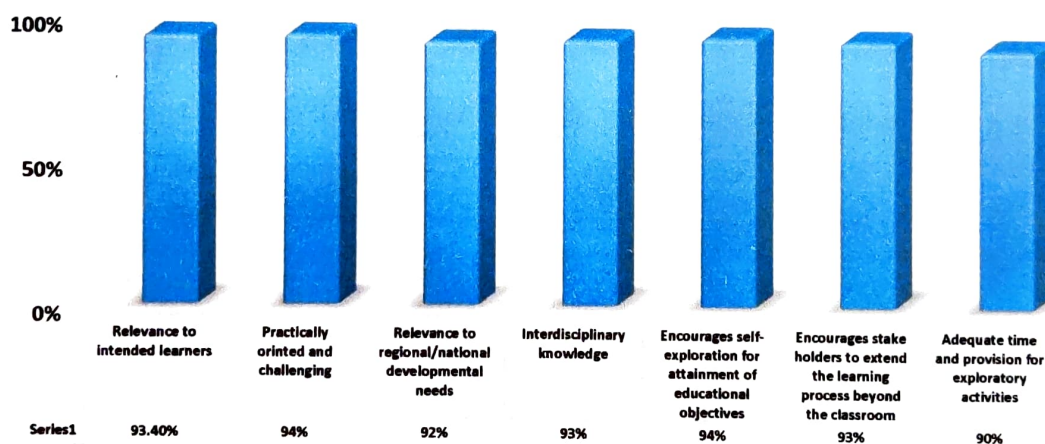

Feedback Analysis Report (2020-2021)

The feedback about curriculum design, delivery and college infrastructure is collected from students, teachers and alumni through a comprehensive questionnaire. The collected feedback is analysed and required actions are taken. The feedback analysis report for session 2020-2021 is summarized below:

Feedback from students about curriculum

Feedback from students about their curriculum design and content is collected and analysed to know about their point of view. The key findings of analysis are discussed here:

Curriculum Design



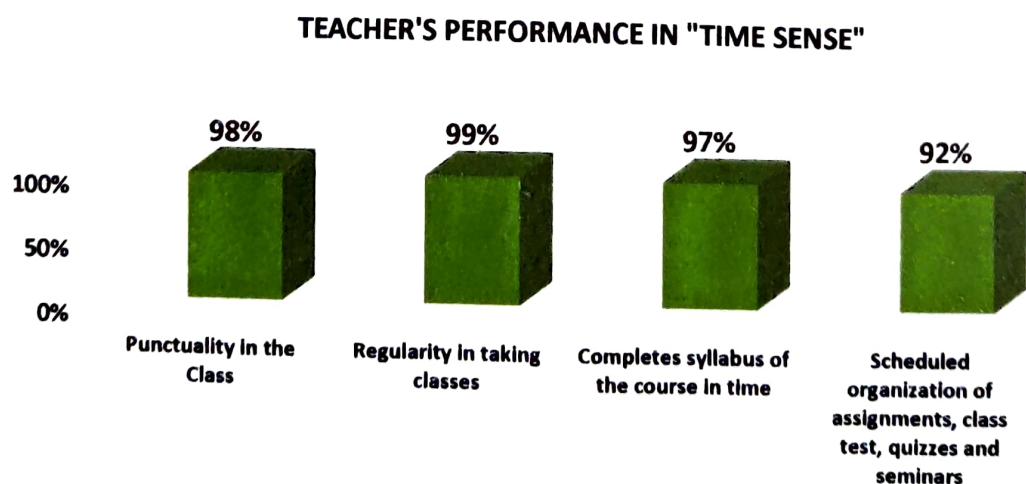
- 93% of students have agreed that curriculum is suitable for intended learners and is according to their respective course objectives. The course content provides in depth knowledge about the course to the students and prepare them for higher studies and job options.
- Most of the students found that course is well designed to provide practical knowledge for better understanding of theoretical concepts. The course content is also found challenging for new learners.

- Around 92% of students do agree that courses syllabi are designed perfectly to meet all the regional and national development needs. The curriculum provides theoretical and practical knowledge to students and make them ready for future requirements of nation.
- Most of the students around 93% also believe that curriculum of their courses also provides them interdisciplinary knowledge along with their main core course according to need of present and future developmental needs.
- Around 94% students have found that course content encourages them to explore things in physical world relevant to their studies and helps them to attain their true educational objectives.
- Most of the students also agree that their courses acquaint them with theoretical and practical knowledge of their respective fields. After course completion, they can successfully apply their knowledge gained during course in the practical world.
- Around 90% of students have claimed that they got sufficient time to explore extracurricular activities along with their courses. They get sufficient time to enhance their different skills along with their studies.

On a broad point of view, it can be said from the above collected data that more than 90% of students found their current course syllabus appropriate to their course objectives.

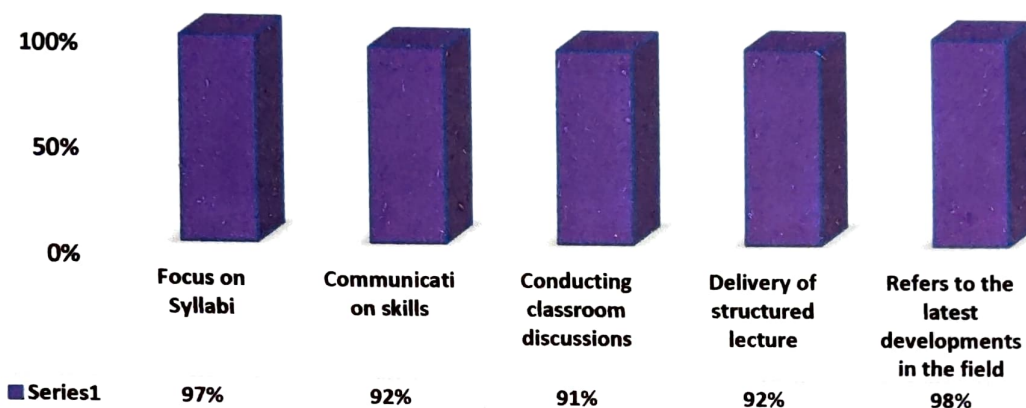
Feedback from students about teacher's performance

Feedback about teacher's performance on different scales like time sense, subject command, use of teaching methods and their helping attitude towards students is collected from students and analysed.



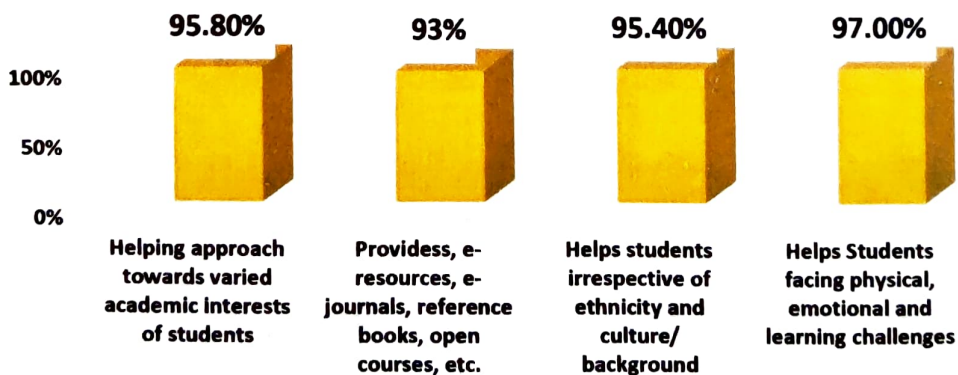
- On time scale, teachers are found to be punctual and regular in taking their classes according to student survey. More than 97% of teachers are found to be regular in their classes and they also complete their course syllabi on time. Around 925 of teachers take regular class tests, quizzes and organize seminar for students to develop their interactive and problem solving skills.

TEACHER'S PERFORMANCE ON 'SUBJECT COMMAND'



- Majority of students (more than 90%) agree that teachers delivered their lectures in a structured way according to the syllabus of course. Teachers also conduct regular group discussions to increase participation during lecture. Teachers are confident and have good communication skills. Teachers also correlate their subject topics with the daily life experiences and latest developments in the field.

TEACHER'S PERFORMANCE ON 'HELPING ATTITUDE'



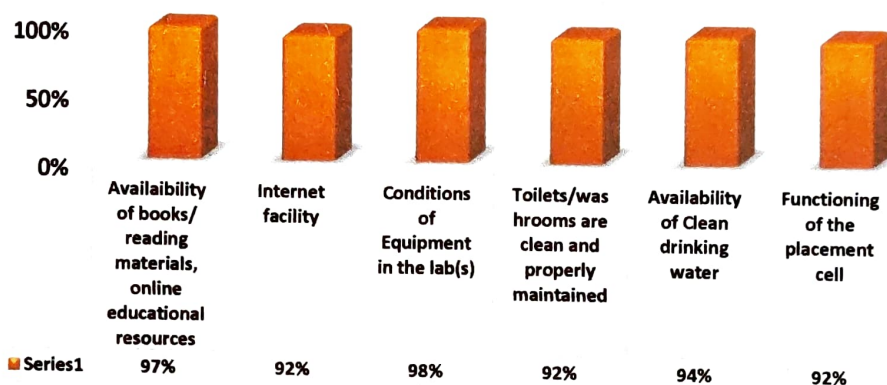
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- More than 93% students found that teachers are cooperative in providing study materials like books, e-books and notes. Teachers do not differentiate among student and help them irrespective of their origin, religion and financial status. Teachers also help students to overcome their physical, emotional and learning challenges.

Feedback from students about college infrastructure

Feedback from students about college infrastructure is collected and analysed, so that appropriate suggestions can be incorporated to improve the college.

FEEDBACK ABOUT COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE



- Majority of students (97%) are satisfied with the books, study materials and online resources available in the library. However, institute is continuously adding new books and study materials in library to provide students every possible book related to their course.
- 92% of students are satisfied with the internet facility provided by college. College Wi-Fi works in every corner of college and students have adequate access to that. Few students had issues with the Wi-Fi speed. College is regularly upgrading its internet facility for better connectivity.
- The equipment's in laboratories are in good condition. The broken or damaged parts are repaired consistently to provide students proper hand on session.
- The students found college campus green and eco-friendly. Although, few students complain about clean drinking water and cleanliness of washroom, accordingly, the

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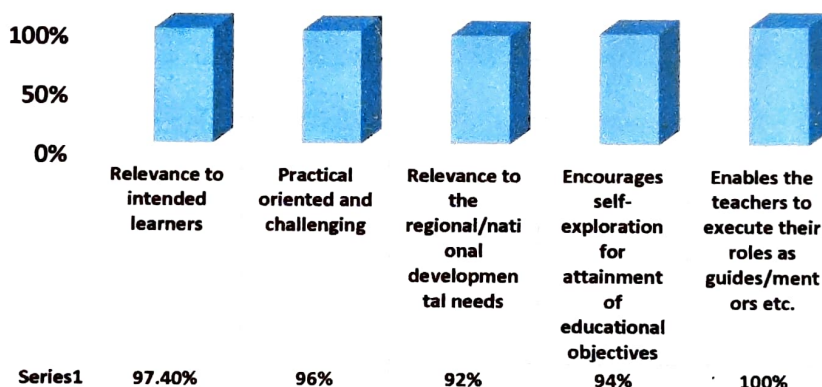
washrooms are properly cleaned and it is ensured that water coolers are cleaned and repaired from time to time.

- Around 92% of students are satisfied with the functioning of placement cell. Placement cell organizes regular seminars and guest lectures to enhance their communication skills and prepare them for future job interviews.

Feedback from Teachers' about Curriculum

Feedback from teachers about curriculum design and delivery is collected and analysed so that proper suggestions and changes can be incorporated for improvisation of curriculum.

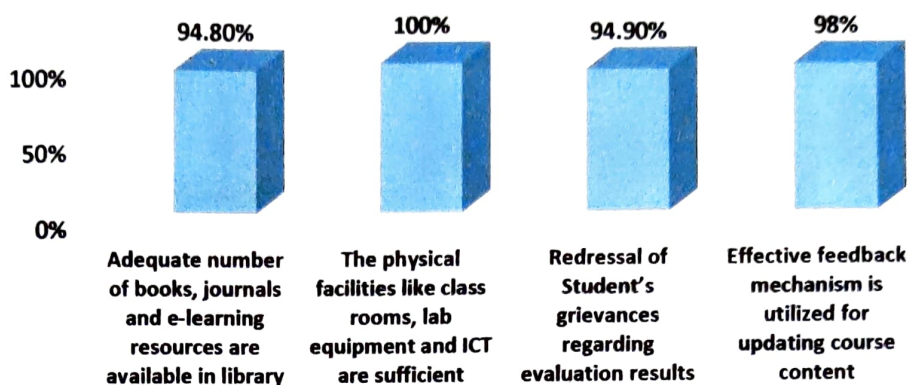
Curriculum Design



- Around 98% of teachers are satisfied with the present curriculum design of different courses. They found that course syllabus are appropriate for intended learners.
- Most of the faculty members (96%) found that curriculum is practically oriented and provides students both the theoretical and practical knowledge.
- Majority of faculty members (92%) do agree that the designed curriculum satisfy the regional and national development needs. The course content is designed in such a way that it enhances their skills and prepare them to meet the future demands of nation.
- Most of the faculty members do agree that curriculum provides sufficient opportunities and time for exploratory activities. Students get sufficient time for extracurricular activities along with their regular classes.

All the faculty members do agree that present curriculum design enable them to execute their roles as mentors and helps them to guide students in every possible way.

Curriculum Delivery



- Most of the faculty members are satisfied with the books and e-resources available in library. But still new books are included in library every year to provide better reading experience to faculty and students.
- All the faculty members strongly agree that lab facilities and ICT are sufficient in college.
- The student's grievances regarding evaluation of results are properly redressed. If any fault is found then proper representation from students duly approved by college authorities is sent to the University for Required Actions.
- Most of the teachers do agree that effective feedback mechanism is followed for updating the course content. Board of studies members update course syllabus regularly according to the demand.

Feedback from alumni

The alumni association of any institution provides a platform for the alumni to share their career experiences with the college and strengthen their bond with the Alma matter. It is also a chance for the institute to improve their administration and infrastructure with their valuable unbiased suggestions.

- Most of the alumni appreciate their quality time spent in the college but they also emphasized on the introduction of the short term job oriented courses and master courses which can provide them better job scope in the industry.
- The alumni of the college also suggest to increase the number of placement drives.
