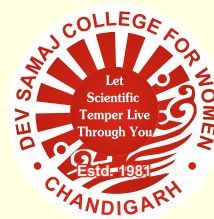

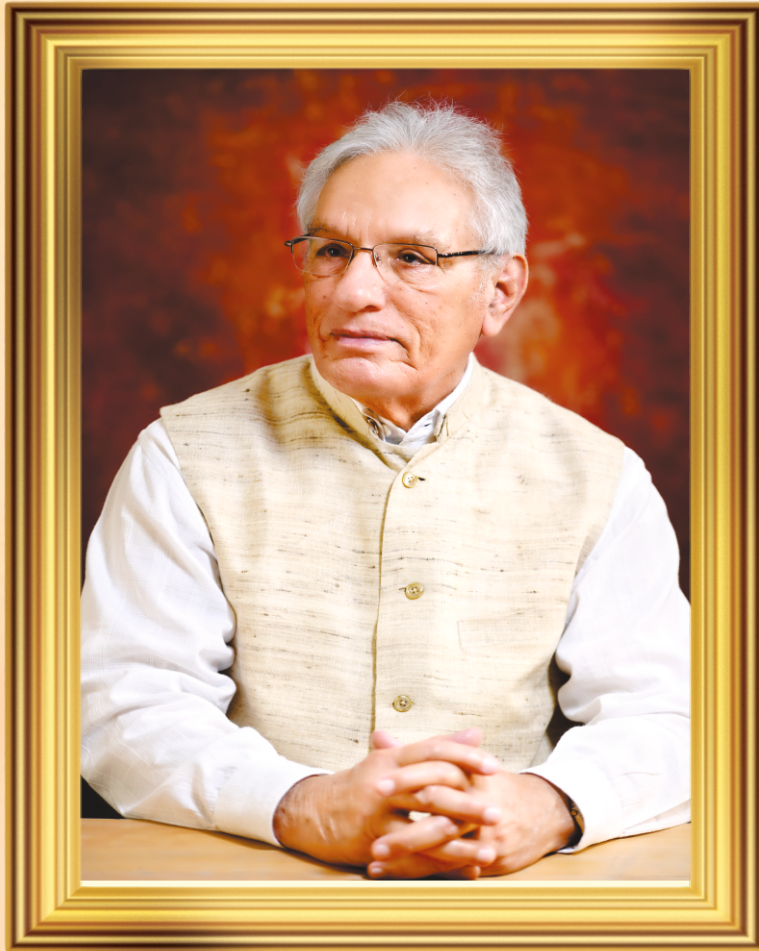

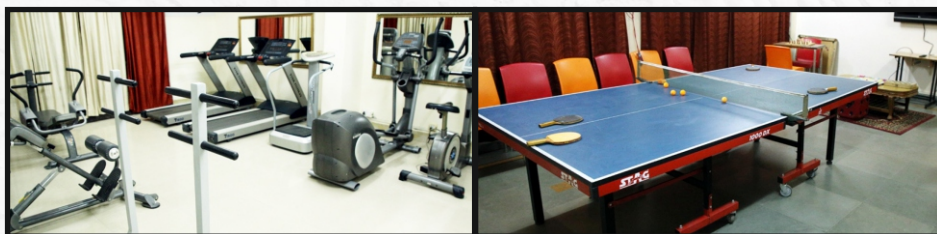

HOSTEL ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The reservation for the hostel seat for the next session is done before leaving the hostel. However the seat may be denied to the old resident if her conduct, attendance and result of house test and semester examinations have not been upto the mark.
- Admission is strictly on merit/availability of seats.
- All the students, old/new seeking hostel only. Admission shall be sought afresh in accommodation is required to fill in the hostel form. This form must be signed by the parents/guardians.
- A medical fitness certificate issued by a competent authority must be attached with the form. It should also carry the information of the blood group of the student and her sensitivity if any, to any medicine.
- The principal/Dean Hostel reserves the rights to grant or refuse admission to any student without

giving any reason

- The student should deposit the full fee on the day of her admission otherwise her admission will be treated as cancelled. Fee and dues once paid will not be refunded.
- Hostel seat is allotted for one academic year only. Admission shall be sought afresh in every academic session.
- Wrong statement of facts or wilful concealing of information may lead to expulsion of the resident.
- Right to hold the discussion to grant or refuse admission to any student rests with the hostel authorities.
- Residents who wish to vacate the hostel during the session must apply to the Principal/Dean hostel in person through the hostel warden. The presence of the parent is mandatory for this purpose.

IMPERATIVE DIRECTIONS FOR PARENTS

1. Only parents or local guardians will be allowed to visit the residents on the visitors day.
2. Prior permission of the warden must be taken to collect your ward.
3. Parents are advised to check the attendance card, house test results and record of the outings and night outs of their wards. Parents are to sign the I-card on a monthly basis.
4. Students should open a Saving Bank Account and carry their ATM cards along for convenient monetary transaction.
5. Change of address/ telephone no. is to be informed to the warden in writing by the parents.

RULES FOR HOSTELLERS



Join Hands with
Us to Prevent Ragging

- Residents are not permitted to stay in the hostel during their college hours. In case of any emergency, special permission from the warden must be taken. Any resident found staying in the room without permission shall be penalized.
- Residents are not allowed to visit any room other than their own.
- Residents must always switch off AC's, fans and lights before leaving their room.
- Attendance in the evening assembly is compulsory for all residents.
- The Principal/Dean hostel/Hostelwardens reserve the right to censor correspondence of the resident.
- No entry in hostel after 6 p.m. for normal residents and 8:30p.m. for residents with special approvals.
- Any kind of shouting, creating rumours, knocking or any other act likely to create disturbance is strictly prohibited in the hostel premises.
- Residents should observe proper discipline in the common room and mess and follow a formal dress code. Residents are not allowed to attend classes in their night dresses.
- Residents must observe study hours strictly from 10:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.
- Playing cards, smoking or taking any kind of non-vegetarian food, eggs, liquor is strictly prohibited. Any resident found guilty of breaking this rule will be expelled from the Hostel without any fee refund.
- Day Scholars are not permitted to visitor stay in the hostel.
- All rooms including almirahs and belongings are open to inspection by the warden/ persons authorized by the principal/Dean hostel.
- Furniture will be provided by the college. The resident will be held responsible for any damage to the furniture or other hostel property. Repair charges for any damages including electric switches, window panes etc. will have to be paid for by the resident concerned.
- Resident will have to return the furniture issued to her before she leaves the hostel. Room of the resident must be left clean on vacating.
- Resident should not deface the walls and doors of their rooms/corridors & should not paint or paste any posters on the walls and on doors. Defaulters will be fined.
- Once a room is allotted and every thing is properly checked, it becomes the students responsibility to maintain all equipments in proper condition otherwise charges will be imposed for any damage.
- They must be in their rooms from 10 PM to 6 AM. Action will be taken against the students found absent from their room or moving about during the above-mentioned hours.
- If students are absents from the college/hostel without any reason/without permission, her parents/guardian will be informed immediately. In cases she does not mend her ways, she will be removed from the rolls of the hostel and the college without any fee refund.
- All routine/serious complaints should be made to the warden only.
- Residents will not be allowed to stay in the hostel during the summer vacation after the University Examinations (theory and practical) are over.
- Residents are advised not to keep excessive cash/jewelry and other valuables with them, the college does not take any responsibility in this matter.
- The hostel will remain closed during summer and winter vacations, as per the Panjab University academic calender.
- **Residents are not allowed to make or receive video call in room.**
- In appropriate dressing not allowed.
- **The hostel will remain closed on the occasion of Diwali.**
- **Every year college celebrates Founders Day in the month of December, for 3 days Residents are adjusted in rooms accordingly. (If required)**
- Residents must clear all their dues before filling the examination form.
- Students will be charged fine for misuse of the laundry. (Undergarments, Shoes are not allowed.)

MESS RULES AND FOOD FACILITY

1. Meals will be served in the Dining Hall only.
2. Students must observe all mess rules in the Dining Hall
3. Residents are not allowed to take meal and mess utensils in their rooms.
4. The Cooking Area is not open to the residents.
4. Residents must behave properly with the mess staff.
5. Good vegetarian Indian and Chinese food is served in the hostel.
6. Residents must observe meal timings.
7. Complaints against food, service, staff should be made to the warden.
8. Wastage of food is strictly prohibited.
9. Residents to be properly dressed in the mess area.
10. Residents must tie their hair before entering dining area.

RULES FOR OUTING

- Outings/Night out will be allowed to residents four times in a month with the permission of the parents.
- Day outings will be allowed on all Sundays from 10.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- Except for long breaks (Diwali, Autumn and Winter) the rest of the outings will be considered local outings.
- Once a student enters the hostel, her first outing will only be after a fortnight.
- Residents availing night out must make entries in night out registers specifying the date and time of departure as well as of arrival.
- Outing/Night out will be signed only after attendance otherwise the resident will be charged fine for not following the instructions.
- Resident must mention their in and out timings in the register kept at the gate.
- Late comers will be allowed to enter the hostel only on submitting their identity cards with the gate keeper.
- Wrong entries in the night out register, and absence from the hostel for the whole night, late arrival without prior permission of the Warden, being an act of gross misconduct can lead to heavy punishment and/or expulsion from the hostel and the college.
- College Main gate will be closed at 7.30 p.m. and no entry will be allowed after that.

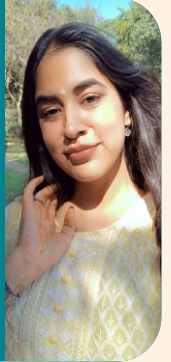
